- (1) The fish are not large because headwaters water levels are very high and we are forced to fish the mouth where water levels are a bit better, but there is, as always, excessive fishing pressure in this area

- (3) Miraculously we were able to cross over the Unini waterfalls with the Amazon Angel Yacht just before water levels dropped! It is now stuck in a low fishing pressure area but water levels are high.
