<p>(1) Fishing is reasonable in terms of numbers but not in size because headwaters water levels are still high in rivers such as the Cuiuini, Urubaxi, etc. And, as such, we are forced to fish in the mouth of other rivers, where water levels are lower, but there is, as always, excessive fishing pressure in this area. However, as expected this time of the year, rain has ceased and we will be moving to the head water where there is no fishing pressure.</p> <p>(2) Water levels are dropping fast and fishing will improve dramatically within next three days.</p>
